



Recommendations for shipping

Cheese, dairy products and charcuteries

There is no need to print this sheet. Only the first pages should be in the package.

Delivery time and address

When you register your products, you will receive an e-mail from us with a dispatch note containing all the important information about the delivery time and address.

Quantity of samples

Cheese and dairy products

Weight of the individual cheese < 50g	4 pieces
Weight of the individual cheese > 50g but < 99g	3 pieces
Weight of the individual cheese > 100g but < 149g	2 pieces
Weight of the individual cheese > 150g but < 499g	1 piece
Weight of the individual cheese > 500g	piece of 500g minimum (4 kg max)
Butter	2 pieces without markings
Milk	1 bottle
Fromage frais / blanc, cream, yoghurt, milk-based dessert, less than 199g	4 cartons
Fromage frais / blanc, cream, yoghurt, milk-based dessert, more than 200g	2 cartons
Cream, yoghurt, frozen dairy dessert less than 199g	4 pots
Cream, yoghurt, frozen dairy dessert over 200g	1 pot

Import documents for deliveries - Delivery from abroad

For an easy and reliable way to send your tasting samples, we recommend using Hillebrand Gori's eShipping service, which manages the consolidated transport of small volumes.

Producers can book online and benefit from coordinated documentation, labelling support, collection and cross-border movement of samples.

If you prefer to arrange transport independently, please ensure that the service you choose offers international delivery with full customs documentation to avoid delays.

Shipping by local post may delay delivery for several weeks due to the complexity of the customs procedure.

Each delivery must come with a detailed business invoice with the following information:

- General data: your company name and address
- The recipient's contact details: Armonia Group UK LTD -Unit 2.9, 159-163 Marlborough Rd, London N19 4NF
- The recipient's EORI number: GB471654185000
- The name of each product
- The unit weight of each product and total weight
- The unit value of each product -> the customs value is 0.50 GBP
- The total value -> the total value of the shipment is less than 20.00 GBP / 20.00 EUR (\$20)
- Mention "Samples for Tasting" – No commercial value and put a label ON the box
- The country of origin
- Add the enclosed commercial invoice signed by a representative of the producer ON the box and INSIDE the box

In addition, depending on the product, specific information is required on the commercial invoice:

Wine, beer, spirits: Alcohol content and exact quantities (e.g.: 2 bottles of 0.75L)

Beer: Degree Plato

Without these indications, the import cannot take place.

- Product name
- Unit weight, total weight
- Unit value
- Total value
- Country of origin

All products entering the United Kingdom are subject to customs duties. These duties are included in the cost of the Consolidated Shipment service offered by the competition.
